Pre-Recorded Pitch Video Instructions

Step 1 Record a 1 Minute Pitch Use a cell phone, video camera, laptop, iPad, or Zoom.

Step 2 Save and Upload Pitch Video:

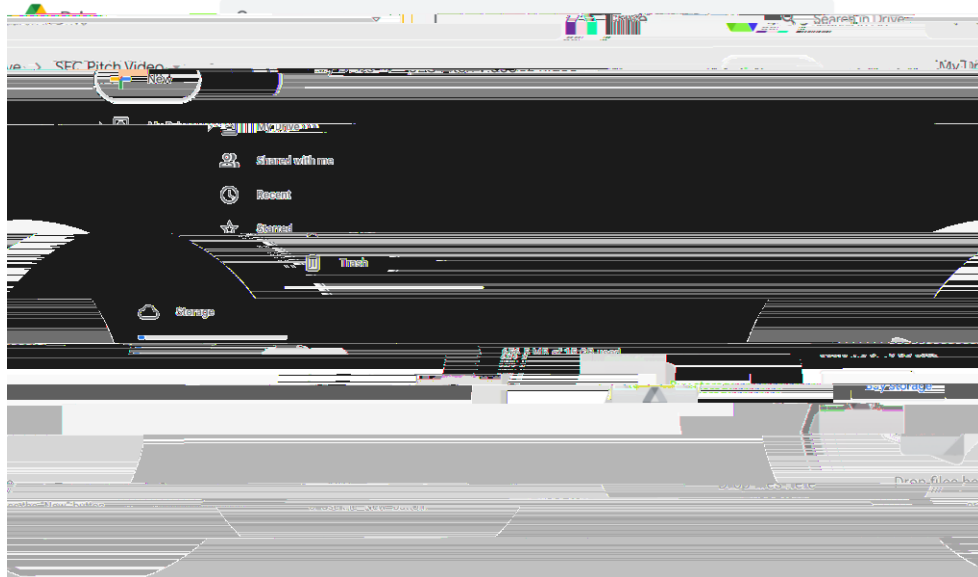
™ After recording your pitch video, save it to your computer.

™ Upload the video to YouTube with a private channel, or save it to your Google Drive and share the weblink See below for Google and YouTube instructions.

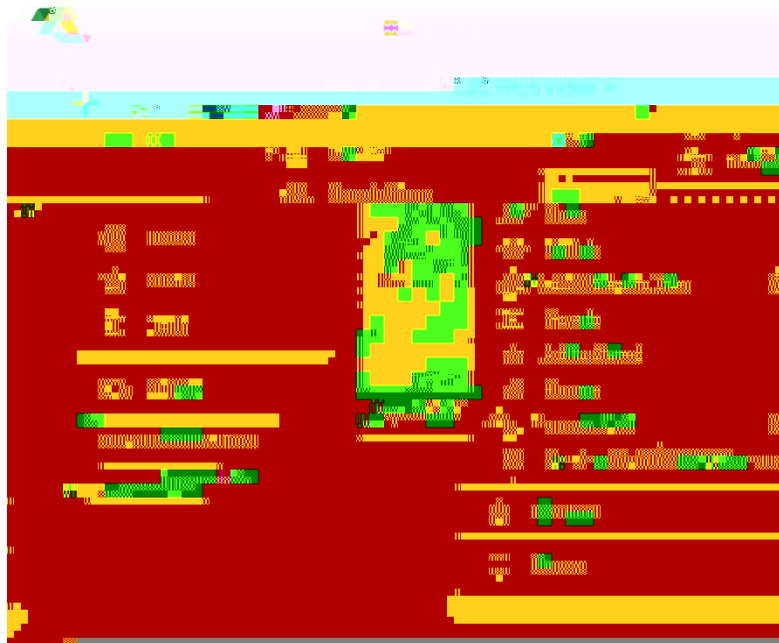
Option 1 Google Drive Link:

™ Step 1- Log into Google Drive. In the top left corner, click on the "New" button and create your folder.

™ Step 2 Select and open the new folder you created in the top left corner, click on the "Upload" button (It is best to add the pitch video to its own folder under your other Google Drive files.)



™ Step 3- Click the name of the folder and the drop-down arrow. Select 'Share'.

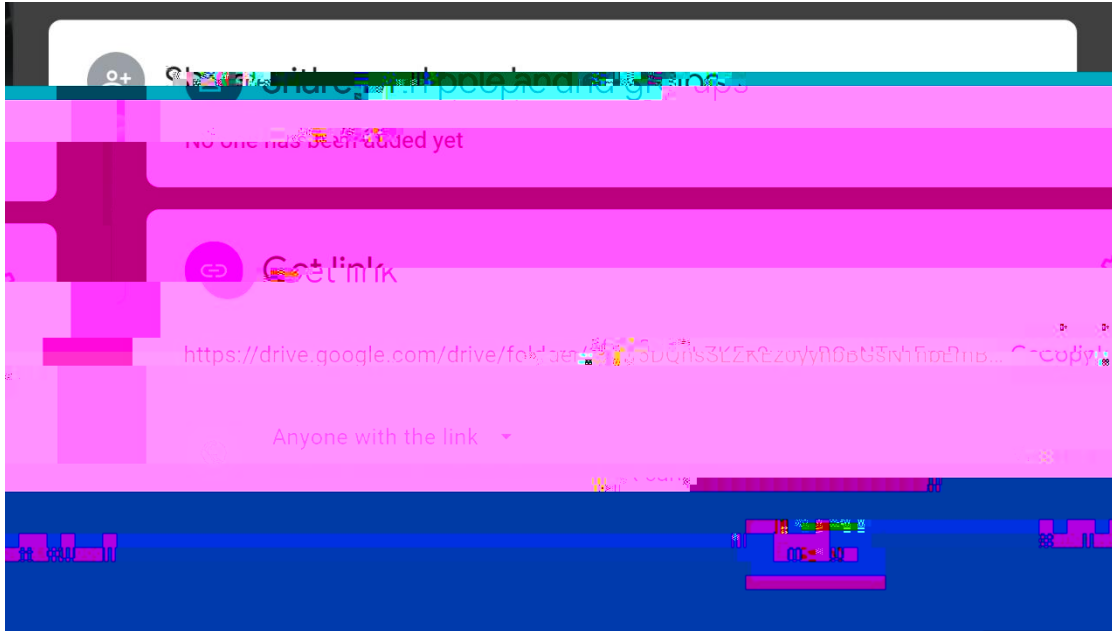

Step 4: In the top right corner of the video, click on the video settings icon (a gear). In the settings menu, click on the 'Privacy' tab. Under 'Who can view this video', select 'Anyone on the internet with the link'. This will allow anyone to watch your video.

Step 4: In the top right corner of the video, click on the video settings icon (a gear). In the settings menu, click on the 'Privacy' tab. Under 'Who can view this video', select 'Anyone with the link'. This will allow anyone to watch your video. It should say 'Viewer' and not 'Commenter' or 'Editor'. Click dropdown to change selection.

Option 2 YouTube Link

Note: YouTube allows you to post videos that are not searchable online but shareable. Viewers must have the link to view.

™ Step 1- Set up a YouTube account using your email/Google address is what we used

™ Step 2 Once the account is created and you have logged in, select the camera button on the top ribbon to upload a video or select create

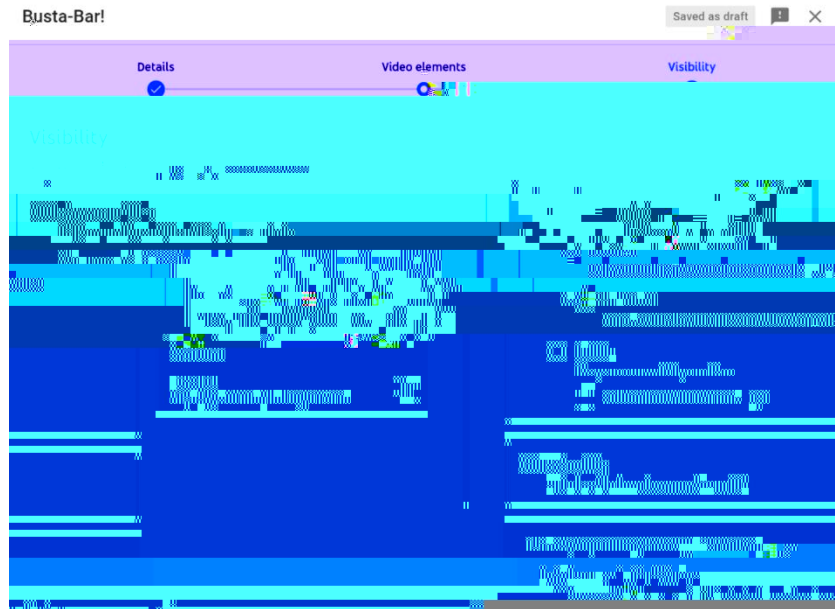
™ Step 3- Follow the steps to upload videos. Options are available to add additional features as well such as trimming, blurring, and other editing features. Uploading a video takes three steps: A. Details, B. Video Elements, and C. Visibility.

x Step A Details: Enter in your title, description, select thumb nail, etc.

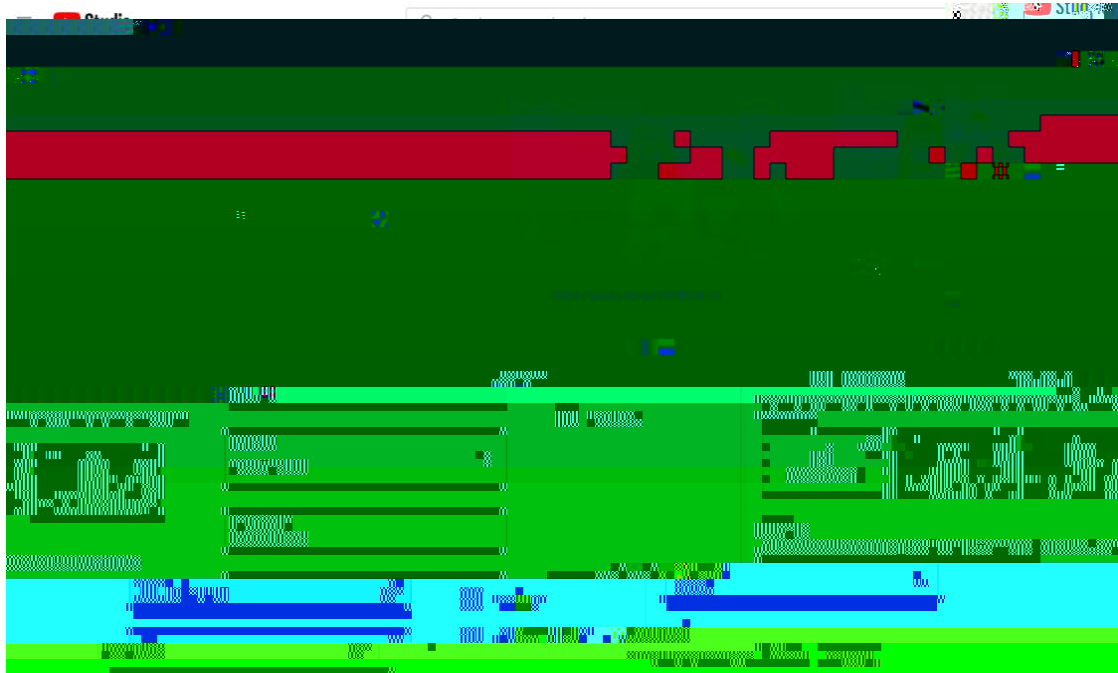

- o Step 3 Visibility: Last step in the uploading process. Visibility - this step allows you to choose if the video is private, open for public viewing, searchable or unlisted. For the competitions, we are allowing anyone with the link to view the video.
